A continued feature of the program is the Campsite Studio Tour where visitors will have the opportunity to appreciate the arts in a natural setting. The Campsite Studio Tour is scheduled to run Saturday, September 15, and Sunday, September 16, from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. The entry fee is \$75.00 per site, which includes entry fee and Friday and Saturday nights' camping fee. Each site may have one to three participants as per park rules. You are encouraged to come and have a look at the campsites to assist in your setup.

For individuals interested in participating for only one day, or would prefer not to camp space can be reserved in our Tent of Arts. Tent space entry fee of \$30 includes Day-Use Park immersion, plus \$10 if you require a table. You may bring your own table if you wish.

Displays are at the discretion of the participants; however, the natural environment must be preserved i.e. no nails in the trees. Works may be displayed on easels, tables or propped on picnic tables or rope strung from tree to tree.

New in 2012 artists will have the option to provide scheduled demonstrations. If you are interested please make note on the registration form. Artists will also have the chance to offer workshops at their own designated times and will supply their own materials and set their own workshop participant fee. We encourage participants to support the Wild for the Arts Festival by donating 20% of their weekend sales to The Friends of MacGregor Point. Tax receipts will be issued.
